Scheme A:

Candidates are required to answer **TWO** questions.

One from Paper 1

One from Paper 2 **OR** 3

Colour must be used for one paper.

The examination paper must not be cut.

PAPER 1
DRAWING AND PAINTING FROM OBSERVATION
(3 Hours)

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:

Carefully complete the information at the back of your examination work;

Rulers and other mechanical means may **NOT** be used;

Candidates should make their preparatory studies and main study from **ONE** of the questions listed below. They must consult with the Art Teacher. Preparatory studies must be mounted on one sheet of paper or **thin** card, taken into the examination room and submitted along with the examination piece;

Any medium or combination of media may be used;

ALL work should be submitted flat;

Answer **ONE** question **ONLY**.

Composition with Natural and Man-Made Forms

1. Arrange any three of the following items: a baking pan, two eggs, a pancake syrup bottle, a small hand grater.
2. Arrange a spray bottle, a small hand towel, a large spool of thread.
3. Arrange a quarter of a pumpkin, an apple and an avocado pear cut in half with the seed.
4. Arrange an ackee branch with no fewer than five leaves and with a closed or opened fruit pod.

The Human Form

5. A model wearing a clear face shield. (Draw from the head to the waist.)
6. A model wearing a chef's hat/cap. (Draw from the head to the waist.)
7. A model with the right hand raised to the forehead in a saluting position. (Draw from the head to the waist.)



PAPER 2
INTERPRETATIVE STUDY
(3 Hours)

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:

Carefully complete the information on the back of your examination work.

Candidates should make their preparatory studies and main study from **ONE** of the subjects listed below. Studies may be made of either the whole or only part of the subject. Preparatory studies must be mounted on one sheet of paper or thin card, taken into the examination room and submitted along with the examination piece.

Where possible, candidates should develop ideas from observation and first-hand experience. Direct copying should be avoided.

Any medium or combination of media may be used.

ALL work should be submitted flat and should **NOT** be larger than 16" × 22"/(40.6 cm × 55.9 cm).

Answer **ONE** question **ONLY**.

1. Someone leaning on a wall in front of a house.
2. A garden filled with many different plants and butterflies.
3. A stage production of people appearing as items related to Art.
4. Someone standing by an open door, taking the temperature of another individual with a hand temperature scanner.
5. An unforgettable experience.
6. It was midnight and ... (Complete the sentence).



PAPER 3
GRAPHIC DESIGN
(3 Hours)

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:

Carefully complete the information on the back of your examination work.

After choosing from the questions listed below, candidates are to make preparatory studies to support their chosen question. They **MUST** consult with the Art teacher when making these studies. These studies must be mounted on one sheet of paper or thin card, taken into the examination room and submitted with the examination piece.

Any medium or combination of media may be used.

ALL work should be submitted flat.

Answer **ONE** question **ONLY**.

Design for Poster/Logo

1. Create and design a poster with the words: "I Care, We Care, Adopt a Pet".
(Measurement 12" × 16")/(30.5 cm × 40.6 cm.)
2. Design a logo for a soup café: 'Simmering Soups' in an area 7" × 7" (17.78 cm × 17.78 cm). Show the identical logo with the same layout and colours on a T-shirt.

Illustration

3. Wow! On the parade were so many different means of transportation, which were so beautifully decorated. The stalls by the roadside had large labels and were also attractively decorated. To the amazement of many, there were also animals in costumes. Numerous people could be seen taking photographs with their favourite cartoon character.
